

Crochet Christmas Star (Left-handed instructions)

- Make a knot and chain 4. Slip stitch for a circle
- Round 1:
 - Popcorn stitch, chain 2, repeat for 5 popcorns
 - Slip stitch the chain 2 into the first popcorn
 - To make a Popcorn: make 4 double crochets. Take the hook out of the last double crochet and insert back into the first double crochet. Pull the last loop (on the fourth double crochet) back through the first double crochet. The 4 will then pop out.
- Round 2: Turn and crochet on the Wrong side
 - 3 double crochets in the chain 2 space, then chain 2
 - Repeat until you have 5
- Round 3: Corners; turn and crochet on the Right Side
 - 3 double crochets in the chain 2 space, then chain 2; 3 more double crochets in the same space, then chain 1
 - Repeat until you have 5 corners
- Round 4: Turn and crochet on the Wrong Side
 - Start with a Single crochet, then chain 2
 - 3 Double crochets in the corner space, then chain 1, and then 3 more double crochets in the same corner
 - Chain 1 and then single crochet in the chain one space from the previous round. Chain another 1
 - Repeat until you return to the first Single Crochet space.
 - Tie or Knot off.
- Add a button and Ribbon.

Note on Double Crochet: You may have to begin a Double Crochet by chaining 3 first. It's up to you if you want to count that first Chain 3 as your First Double Crochet. Or you may ignore it and make a Double Crochet. Sometimes ignoring the first chain 3 is the easiest way to go.
