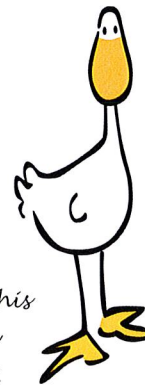

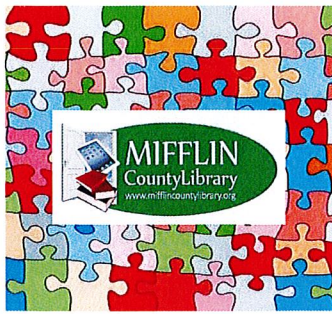

## **2019 Goose Day Puzzle Competition Rules**

1. The competition begins at 1 p.m. and ends when Dr. Molly blows the final whistle at 3 p.m.
2. Each team has its own table and chairs. No tables may be moved.
3. All teams have the very same puzzle, facedown on the table. No peeking! (This means YOU!)
4. All members of the team should be at the table and ready to turn the puzzle box over and begin when Dr. Molly blows her whistle. Dawdlers will be barred.
5. You have to stay at your table. No distracting other puzzlers! (YOU again!)
6. If you have a questions, ask Ms. Mary (Do not ask other puzzlers. They may be confused. Ms. Mary has all the correct answers.)
7. Your friends can watch from the sidelines, but no coaching is allowed. Violators will be sent home.
8. No heckling allowed. Hecklers will be severely admonished.
9. There will be official breaks. If you have to use the restroom, put up your hand and Ms. Susan will give you permission.
10. No food or drinks at the table. Clean hands, please, people!
11. When the first team is finished, they must shout, "Jigsaw!" Everyone must stop adding pieces. Ms. Kathy will confirm that the puzzle has been accurately assembled.
12. After announcing the winner, Dr. Molly will blow her whistle to begin the 10 minute run-off period.
13. If a team finishes during the runoff, they must shout, "Jigsaw!". That team will be the 2nd place winner, when the puzzle is approved. The other teams may continue until the end of the period after Dr. Molly blows her whistle again.
14. If there is no winner during the period, second place will be awarded to the team with the fewest unpuzzled pieces left on their table at the end of the run-off.
15. Third place goes to the team with the next fewest pieces.
16. In the event of a tie, the tied teams will have another 5 min. to add pieces to their puzzle. The team with the fewest remaining pieces is the winner.
