WHAT IS THE LIBRARY OF CONGRESS

VETERANS HISTORY PROJECT?

The Veterans History Project collects and preserves firsthand interviews of United States military veterans (war & peace) from World War I through the present.



HOW ARE INTERVIEWS CONDUCTED?

Veterans will be interviewed in a respectful manner in a quiet location at the Mifflin County Library by one of the library staff members.

Veterans are welcome to have someone accompany them.



EXAMPLES OF WHAT WILL YOU BE ASKED?

Biographical

Where were you born?

Who are/were your parents and occupations?

What schooling and/or jobs did you have prior to service?

Early Days of Service

How/Why did you join?

What branch of service and why?

What training/schooling did you receive in the service?

What was your first assignment after basic training?

Wartime Service

Where did you serve?

What are your recollections of that experience?

What friendships and camaraderie did you form?

End of Service

How did your military service experience change your life?

How were you received by your family and community?

Did you join a veterans organization?

What message would you like to leave for future generations?

Reflections

How did the military affect your life?

What are some lessons learned from the service?

Conclusion
